

# PROJECT INTRODUCTION



## WHAT IS THIS EVENT?

**Bluestone Energy Ltd. is in the process of applying for Planning Permission to build a Battery Energy Storage System (BESS) and associated infrastructure at Malcolmwood Farm, Blantyre, G72 9UL.**

The proposed development seeks permission for a 49.5MW BESS plus ancillary infrastructure. In April 2025, a Screening Opinion request was submitted to South Lanarkshire Council for the proposed development, which determined that an Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) was not required. Given the proposed output of 49.5MW, the application is classed as Major and therefore two public consultation events are required to gather feedback and opinions from local residents.

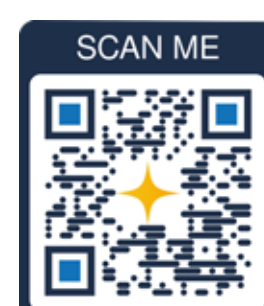

In the lead up to this event, leaflets about the project have been circulated to the nearby properties and an advert appeared in the Hamilton Advertiser one week in advance.

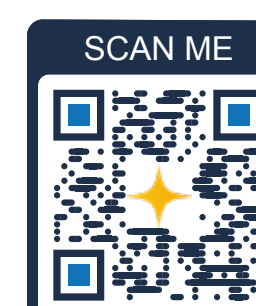

Project **Chessington BESS**

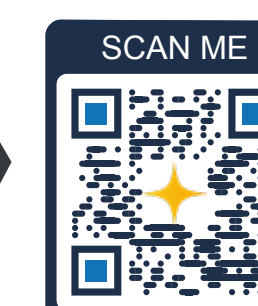


Project **Dougliehill BESS**
